Getting this sorted upfront saves time and sets the right expectations. - ****Know when it's time to upgrade.**** When a discontinued opener has reached the end of its serviceable life, the practical call is to recommend a current-generation replacement. Customers get modern features — app connectivity, improved safety technology, battery backup compatibility — along with full manufacturer support. - ****Remote compatibility needs attention.**** Many older openers use 303MHz or other frequencies that are no longer in production. Easylifter — sectional door openers

The Easylifter was B&D's main residential sectional door opener before the SDO/GDO series came along. It was a reliable workhorse that served Australian homes well for many years.
