Common owner questions

Here are the topics homeowners ask about most often.

How do I use the manual release?

Pull the red emergency release cord, which hangs from the trolley on the drive rail. This disconnects the door from the opener so you can move it by hand — useful during a power outage when you'd otherwise be stuck.

To reconnect, push the door to the closed position and run the opener. The trolley re-engages automatically.

The manual release position and procedure can vary by model, so check your specific owner's manual to confirm the correct steps for your system.

How do I add or erase a remote?

Remote programming varies by model. Check the "Programming" or "Remote Coding" section of your owner's manual for step-by-step instructions. You can also find detailed guidance in the [remote coding guides](<https://www.bnd.com.au/trade-resources/installation-manuals/accessories-remotes-manuals/>).

How do I adjust the open and close limits?

On older models, limit adjustment is done via screws on the motor housing. On newer models (SmartPro, GDO series), limits are set through the wall button menu or the B&D; app. Your owner's manual covers the exact process for your model.

My opener is beeping or flashing — what does it mean?

Start with the fault and error code table in your owner's manual. Common causes include a low battery backup, a safety beam obstruction, the door not reaching full travel, or limit settings that need a minor adjustment. In most cases the fix is straightforward, and the manual will walk you through it.

How do I maintain my garage door and opener?

****Lubrication:**** Apply a silicone or garage door-specific lubricant to rollers, hinges, and the drive chain or belt once a year. WD-40 isn't suitable for this — it's not a long-term lubricant.

****Spring inspection:**** Springs are under significant tension and should only be inspected or adjusted by a qualified technician. If a spring breaks, don't attempt to repair it yourself — call a licensed B&D; dealer.

****Safety test:**** Once a month, place a 40 mm block under the door and close it. This checks that the auto-reverse feature is working correctly.
