Sheer Panel: Alpolic Aluminium Composite

The B&D; Sheer Panel is the flagship of B&D;'s designer range, and it's the door that architects reach for when the brief calls for uncompromising modern design. Built on the Panelift Icon platform, the Sheer Panel uses Alpolic aluminium composite — the same material specified for premium commercial facades, architectural cladding, and high-end fitouts across Australia and internationally.

What Makes Alpolic Different

Alpolic is a true aluminium composite material: two thin aluminium sheets bonded to a solid core, creating a panel that's remarkably flat, rigid, and lightweight. Unlike standard steel garage door skins, Alpolic delivers a perfectly flush surface with no visible panel joins when the door is closed. The result is a seamless wall of colour that reads as architecture, not as a garage door.

This flush-mount design is central to the Sheer Panel's appeal. The aluminium composite panels sit within a framework that eliminates the traditional ribbed or raised panel look entirely. When closed, the door presents as a single, unbroken surface — exactly what contemporary architects want for clean-line facades.

This dimensional quality is what separates Natural Finishes from standard printed finishes: from a metre away, visitors experience actual texture, not a photograph of texture.

The Panelift Icon platform underneath delivers the same premium features as the Sheer Panel: AUTO LOCK, Smooth-Track, Pinchfree design, 360-degree perimeter seals, stainless-steel cables, and 20,000 spring cycles. The performance is identical — only the aesthetic changes.
