****Cycle testing**** is at the core of B&D;'s quality assurance. Every door and opener combination is put through rigorous testing — up to 20,000 cycles and beyond — simulating years of real-world operation before a product ever reaches your home. That means the door you install today has already proven it can handle a decade or more of daily opens and closes.

****Warranty protection**** provides additional confidence. B&D; offers comprehensive warranty coverage on their doors and openers, with service intervals designed to maintain peak performance across years of operation. The recommended service schedule — at 12 months, 3 years, 5 years, 7 years, and 9 years after installation — ensures your door is professionally checked at each milestone, with warranty coverage maintained through proper servicing by an authorised dealer.

When a door is professionally installed and properly maintained, it becomes one of those things you simply stop thinking about — it just works.

Easy Operation

One of the most common concerns we hear from retirees is: ****"Will I be able to operate it easily?"*** The answer is a definitive yes — and here's why.

****Simple remote controls.**** B&D; openers use TrioCode™128 remote control transmitters with encrypted security. But from the user's perspective, it's beautifully simple: press the button, the door opens. Press it again, the door closes. The remote can be kept on your car visor, in a pocket, or on a key ring. No complicated sequences, no settings to remember.

****Clear status indicators.**** The Power Drive and Smart Pro openers feature LED status lights that tell you exactly what's happening — the door is opening, closing, fully open, or fully closed. No guessing, no squinting at the door from the car.

****Wall-mounted control button.**** Inside your garage, a wall-mounted button provides the same open/stop/close function. One button, clearly positioned, easy to reach.

****Wireless keypad entry.**** For those moments when you've left the remote inside or want to give a tradesperson access, the optional wireless keypad lets you operate the door with a simple PIN code. It mounts on the wall outside your garage and uses the same TrioCode™128 security. You can even program a temporary code — say, 0000 for a visiting tradesperson — then reset it when they're done. It

runs on standard AAA batteries and has a backlit keypad for easy use at night.

****The Smartphone Control Kit**** takes convenience one step further. If you've ever driven away and thought **"Did I close the garage door?"**, this is the answer. You can check your door's status from anywhere on your phone and close it remotely if you forgot. But we'll cover the smart features in detail a bit later — for now, the key point is this: operating a B&D; garage door is as easy as pressing a single button.

Safety Features for Peace of Mind

When grandchildren visit and pets wander, your garage door needs to be safe — automatically and without relying on anyone remembering to check.

****Automatic safety reverse**** is built into every B&D; opener. If the door encounters an obstruction while closing, it automatically reverses direction. The system measures the closing force and triggers a reversal if resistance exceeds safe limits. The closing force threshold is set at 400N (approximately 40kg) for most openers, and even lower at 150N (15kg) for certain models. This means the door will reverse before it can cause harm to a child, pet, or even a bicycle left in the doorway.

****Monthly testing is simple.**** B&D; recommends a quick test once a month: place a 40mm board on the floor under the centre of the door, then close the door. It should reverse on contact with the board. That's it — a 30-second check that confirms your safety system is working perfectly.

****Safety Beams**** provide an additional layer of protection. These infrared sensors project a beam across the garage door opening. If anything — a child, a pet, a pram — breaks the beam while the door is closing, the door stops immediately. Unlike the contact-based safety reverse, Safety Beams detect obstructions ***before*** the door makes contact, preventing any impact at all. Safety Beams are required when a smart device is fitted to operate the door remotely (when you're not in line-of-sight), making them standard in any smartphone-connected setup.

****Emergency manual release**** gives you control even when the opener can't operate. Every B&D; opener includes a manual release mechanism — typically a cord or handle — that lets you disengage the opener and operate the door by hand. This is important during extended power failures (if you don't have battery backup) or in emergency situations. B&D; recommends practising this with the door in the closed position, so you're comfortable with the process before you ever need it.

****LED courtesy lights**** on the Smart Pro and Power Drive openers illuminate your garage automatically when the door operates. The high-efficiency LED lights feature longer life cycles than traditional globes and include a dimming function. This means no fumbling in a dark garage — the light comes on when you need it and dims when you don't.

Together, these safety features create a system that protects your family passively — no vigilance required.

Battery Backup: Don't Get Locked Out

Power failures happen. In older homes and established neighbourhoods, they can happen more frequently. If your garage is your primary entry point — as it is for many downsizers and retirees — a power failure can leave you literally locked out of your home.

The ****B&D; Battery Backup Kit**** is the solution, and it's straightforward:

- ****Approximately 10 open/close cycles**** on battery power — enough to last through most outages -
- **Two 12V sealed lead-acid batteries**** (2.3Ah each, 24V total) provide reliable backup power -

****Average cycle time**** of around 40 seconds per garage door operation - ****24 to 48 hours**** to fully recharge once mains power is restored

The Battery Backup Kit is particularly important for single-entry garages, where the garage door is the only way in and out without going outside. For retirees who may have mobility challenges, being locked out in bad weather is more than an inconvenience — it can be a genuine safety concern.

Even if your home has a separate front entry, the Battery Backup Kit eliminates the stress of a power failure. You simply press your remote as usual, and the door opens. No manual lifting, no wrestling with emergency releases, no calling for help.

B&D; recommends running a monthly check to ensure the batteries remain in good condition. It's as simple as disconnecting mains power briefly and testing that the door operates on battery — a quick routine that takes less than a minute.

For downsizers moving to a townhouse or villa with an integrated garage, we consider the Battery Backup Kit an essential addition, not an optional extra.

Low Maintenance Living

One of the best things about a B&D; garage door is how little attention it needs. The entire system is designed for low-maintenance living — exactly what you want in retirement.

****Colorbond® steel**** is the material of choice for B&D; doors, and it's a game-changer for maintenance. Colorbond doors are pre-painted with a high-durability silicone-modified polyester paint system specifically designed and tested for harsh Australian conditions. This is one of the best paint films commercially available — it resists corrosion, UV damage, and atmospheric pollution.

The practical benefit? ****Your garage door never needs painting.**** No sanding, no priming, no weekend spent with a roller and drop sheets. The factory-applied finish is designed to last the life of the door.

The only maintenance Colorbond requires is a basic wash. B&D; recommends washing the door every 14 days with clean water and a soft brush or cloth to remove atmospheric deposits. Pay extra attention to areas not normally washed by rain. In coastal or industrial areas, more frequent washing is advisable. As B&D; puts it: ****"When you think of cleaning your car, think of washing your door."***

****Nylofelt® running strips**** are another low-maintenance innovation. Fitted along the guide tracks of Roll-A-Door curtains, Nylofelt strips provide a protective barrier between the door curtain and the steel guides. They reduce vibration, minimise metal-to-metal contact, dampen noise during operation, and distribute the load more evenly across the guide surface. The result is smoother, quieter operation and reduced wear on both the door and the guides over time.

B&D; recommends checking that the Nylofelt strips haven't slipped or become jammed at least every six months — a quick visual check that takes under a minute.

****The opener itself**** contains no user-serviceable parts and requires virtually no day-to-day maintenance. B&D; recommends an annual professional service by an authorised dealer for maximum efficiency and warranty coverage. Think of it like a car service — once a year, a professional checks everything is running optimally, and you don't have to think about it in between.

****Dealer servicing**** is available through B&D;'s extensive network of accredited dealers across Australia. They handle everything from routine servicing to spring tension adjustments and any operational checks that should only be performed by a qualified technician.

Smartphone Monitoring

The B&D; Smartphone Control Kit adds a layer of convenience that's particularly valuable for retirees — but only the features you'll actually use. No gimmicks, no unnecessary complexity.

****Check your door status from anywhere.**** The app shows you whether your garage door is open or closed, in real time. Whether you're at the shops, visiting family, or travelling, you can glance at your phone and know your home is secure.

****Close the door remotely.**** Forgot to close the door when you left? Close it from your phone, wherever you are. No need to drive back home.

****Activity log.**** The app keeps a record of every time your door opens and closes. You can see exactly when it was used and know if anything unexpected has happened while you were away.

****Door-left-open alerts.**** If the door is left open or obstructed, you'll receive an alert on your phone. This catches those moments when the door didn't fully close and you didn't notice.

****Share access with family.**** You can add multiple users to the app, each with their own password and varying levels of access. This is especially useful for retirees whose adult children or carers may want to check in. Your daughter interstate can see on her phone that your garage door closed properly after you got home — without calling to check.

****Multiple locations.**** If you have a holiday house or manage more than one property, you can monitor and control doors across different locations from a single app.

The setup requires linking the Smartphone Control Kit to your home WiFi network. Once connected, operation works through your phone's cellular or WiFi connection. B&D; notes that Safety Beams are required when operating the door remotely (since you're not in line-of-sight), which is why the premium package recommendation above includes them as standard.

The beauty of the Smartphone Kit for retirees isn't the technology itself — it's the peace of mind. You never have to wonder, you just check. And your family can keep an eye on things without being intrusive.

Downsizer Package Recommendation

Here's what we'd recommend for a typical downsizer or retiree, with two options depending on your budget and priorities.

****What to prioritise on a retirement budget:**** If funds are limited, start with the door and opener. The Battery Backup Kit can be added later, as can the wireless keypad. But if your garage is your primary entry, we'd strongly recommend including the Battery Backup Kit from day one.

Frequently Asked Questions

How easy is it to use? Very easy. Day-to-day operation is a single button press on your remote control — press once to open, press again to close. There are no sequences to remember, no codes to enter (unless you're using the optional keypad), and no complicated settings. Wall-mounted buttons inside the garage work the same way. If you can use a TV remote, you can operate a B&D; garage door.

What if the power goes out? With the Battery Backup Kit installed, your opener continues to work normally — you'll get approximately 10 open/close cycles on battery power, which is enough to last

through most outages. Without battery backup, you can manually disengage the opener using the emergency release cord and operate the door by hand. B&D; recommends practising the manual release so you're familiar with it before you ever need it.

****Can my children monitor my garage door?**** Yes. With the Smartphone Control Kit, you can add multiple users to the app, each with their own password and access level. Your adult children can check whether your garage door is open or closed from their own phones, anywhere in Australia (or the world). They'll see door status, activity history, and receive alerts if the door is left open. It's a non-intrusive way for family to have peace of mind about your safety.

****How long will it last?**** B&D; garage doors are built to last. With proper installation and regular servicing (annual check-ups by a B&D; Accredited Dealer), a B&D; door and opener can serve reliably for well over a decade. The Colorbond steel finish is designed to last the life of the door without repainting, and the opener's service schedule extends to 9+ years with defined milestones. Many B&D; customers report their doors still performing perfectly after 15 to 20 years.

****Do I need the Smartphone Kit, or is the remote control enough?**** The remote control is absolutely sufficient for most people. The Smartphone Kit is an upgrade for those who want the ability to check door status remotely and share access with family members. If you frequently forget to close the door, or if your family likes to check in on your home security, it's a worthwhile addition. If you're happy with a simple press-the-button operation, the standard remote controls are all you need.

****How often does it need servicing?**** B&D; recommends a monthly safety test (30 seconds — place a board under the door and confirm it reverses), a visual check of Nylofelt® strips every six months, and an annual professional service by an accredited dealer. Between services, the only regular maintenance is washing the Colorbond door with water and a soft cloth every couple of weeks. It's genuinely minimal.
