B&D; offers two clear paths to a smart garage: the Smart Pro with built-in Wi-Fi for new installations, or the Smartphone Control Kit to retrofit intelligence onto any compatible B&D; opener. Both connect to the B&D; app for remote open/close, real-time status monitoring, geofencing, scheduled auto-close, visitor access codes, and multi-door control from anywhere. Whether you're building a connected home from scratch or upgrading an existing setup, B&D;'s smart ecosystem delivers genuine convenience and security without complexity.

Two Paths to a Smart Garage

If you're a smart home enthusiast looking at garage door automation, you've essentially got two paths with B&D;, and the right one depends on where you're starting from.

****Path 1: New installation or replacement.**** If you're installing a new opener — whether it's a new build, a renovation, or replacing an old unit — the B&D; Smart Pro (SDO-9V3) is the straightforward choice. Wi-Fi is built directly into the opener. There's no additional hardware to buy, no extra hub to configure, and no secondary device consuming a power outlet. You install the opener, connect it to your home Wi-Fi network during setup, download the B&D; app, and you're controlling your garage door from your phone immediately.

****Path 2: Existing B&D; opener you want to make smart.**** If you already have a B&D; opener that's working perfectly well — a Power Drive, Roll-A-Pro, Secure, or even a Smart model without built-in connectivity — the Smartphone Control Kit (MC0006) adds full app-based control without replacing your entire opener. The kit includes a Smart Hub that connects to your opener and your home Wi-Fi, bridging the gap between your existing hardware and the B&D; app.

Decision Tree

Ask yourself these questions:

1. ****Are you installing a new opener?**** → Smart Pro. No contest. You get smart features included at no extra accessory cost.
2. ****Do you have a working B&D; opener manufactured after May 2016?**** → Smartphone Control Kit. Full smart features without the cost of a new opener.
3. ****Is your opener**

pre-May 2016? → Check compatibility with your B&D; dealer. Some earlier models may not support the Smart Hub. 4. **Do you have a non-B&D; opener? → The Smartphone Control Kit is designed for B&D; openers. You'll likely need to look at a new B&D; opener installation.

Smart Pro: Smart From Day One

The B&D; Smart Pro (SDO-9V3) is B&D;'s flagship sectional door opener, and it's built for people who want everything integrated from the start.

What Makes It the Smart Choice

The defining feature is the built-in Wi-Fi module. Where other openers in the B&D; range require an additional Smart Hub to connect to your network, the Smart Pro has this capability integrated into the control board. This means:

- **Fewer points of failure.** No separate hub that could lose connection or need its own power supply.
- **Cleaner installation.** One device on your ceiling, connected to your Wi-Fi. Done.
- **Immediate app access.** As soon as the opener is installed and connected to your network, you can set up the B&D; app and start controlling your door remotely.

The Smart Pro also features Dynamic Door Profiling — the opener automatically learns and compensates for changing door characteristics with each operation. As springs age or weather affects the door, the opener adjusts. It's the kind of invisible intelligence that smart home enthusiasts appreciate.

Compatible Doors

The Smart Pro operates sectional garage doors up to 18m² and 300kg. The door must be well-balanced and capable of being operated by hand, as per warranty conditions and AS/NZS 4505:2012 standards. This covers the vast majority of standard residential sectional doors.

Smartphone Control Kit: Make Any B&D; Opener Smart

Already have a B&D; opener that's running well? The Smartphone Control Kit (MC0006) is the retrofit solution that brings full app control to your existing setup.

What's in the Kit

- **MC0006:** Complete Smart Hub control kit (includes Smart Hub and all accessories) - **MC0008:** Smart Hub only (available separately if you only need the hub) - **MC0009:** Transceiver only (available separately)

Compatible Openers

The Smartphone Control Kit works with B&D;'s range of residential openers, including:

- **Power Drive** — B&D;'s sectional door opener range
- **Roll-A-Pro** — For roller doors
- **Secure** (SDO-6V3) — Entry-level sectional door opener
- **Smart** (SDO-7V3) — Mid-range sectional door opener

****Important compatibility note:**** Openers manufactured prior to May 1st, 2016 may not be compatible with the Smartphone Control Kit. Check with your B&D; dealer or representative if you're unsure about your opener's manufacture date.

How It Works

The Smart Hub connects to your existing opener via the included transceiver, and to your home Wi-Fi network. Once connected, it acts as a bridge — your phone talks to the Smart Hub via the internet (through your Wi-Fi router), and the Smart Hub communicates with your opener. The result is the same app-based control you'd get with a Smart Pro, just delivered through a separate piece of hardware.

Setup involves mounting the Smart Hub within range of both your opener and your Wi-Fi router, pairing it with the opener, and configuring it through the B&D; app. Most B&D; authorised dealers can install and configure the kit during a standard service call.

Safety Beams Are Mandatory

This is non-negotiable: ****Safety Beams must be installed when using the Smartphone Control Kit.**** Because smart phone control allows you to operate the door when you're not in line of sight — you could be at work, at the shops, or simply in another room — Safety Beams are required to detect any obstructions in the door's path and override automatic operation if one is present.

This requirement is in accordance with AS/NZS 60335-2-95:2012. It's not optional, and it's not just a good idea — it's a safety standard that protects people, pets, and property.

What You Can Do From the App

Once you're connected — whether through a Smart Pro's built-in Wi-Fi or a Smartphone Control Kit — the B&D; app gives you a consistent set of features:

Open and Close From Anywhere

The obvious one, but worth stating clearly: you can open and close your garage door from anywhere with an internet connection. At work and the kids need to get their bikes out? Open it. Lying in bed and can't remember if you closed the garage? Check and close it. On holiday and a tradesperson needs access? Grant it.

Real-Time Status Monitoring

The app shows you whether your door is open, closed, or somewhere in between — in real time. No guessing, no driving back to check.

Activity Log

Every door operation is recorded in an activity log. You can see exactly when the door was opened or closed, and by whom. This is invaluable for families (did the kids get home from school?), for rental properties (is the tenant accessing the garage at odd hours?), and for general peace of mind.

Geofencing

Set a virtual perimeter around your home. When your phone crosses that boundary on the way home, the door opens automatically. When you leave, it closes. More on this below — it's genuinely one of the best smart home features B&D; offers.

Scheduled Close

Set the door to close at a specific time every day. The classic use: close at 10pm every night, whether you remembered or not.

Visitor Access

Generate one-time access codes for trusted visitors — electricians, gardeners, cleaners, delivery drivers. They get temporary access without your permanent codes or remotes, and the access expires after use.

Multi-Door Control

If you have multiple garage doors, you can control them all from a single app. One dashboard, multiple doors.

Multi-Location Management

Own a holiday house? Investment property? Multiple business sites? The app lets you manage garage doors across multiple locations from a single account. You're not limited to one property.

Geofencing: The Killer Feature

If there's one feature that converts sceptics into smart garage enthusiasts, it's geofencing. Here's why.

How It Works

Geofencing uses your phone's GPS to create a virtual boundary around your home — typically a radius of a few hundred metres. The B&D; app monitors your phone's location in the background. When you cross into the geofence zone (driving home from work, for example), the app automatically sends an open command to your garage door. When you leave the zone, it sends a close command.

Why It's Brilliant

Think about your current garage routine. You drive home. You reach for the remote — where is it? Visor? Console? Pocket? You press the button. You wait for the door to open. You drive in. You press the button again. You get out of the car.

With geofencing, you drive home. The door is already opening as you turn into your street. You drive straight in. The door closes behind you as you walk inside. You never touched a button, reached for a remote, or opened an app. It just works.

Practical Considerations

- **Accuracy** depends on your phone's GPS and how well it can determine your location in your specific area. In most suburban settings, it works reliably. - **Battery impact** is minimal. Modern phones handle background location monitoring efficiently, and the B&D; app uses low-power geofencing APIs rather than continuous GPS tracking. - **Multiple phones** can be configured with geofencing, so both you and your partner's arrivals and departures trigger the door. - **Safety Beams** are required when using geofencing with auto-close, as the door is operating without anyone watching it.

Auto-Close and Scheduling

For smart home enthusiasts, automation isn't just about remote control — it's about setting up systems that handle the routine stuff without you.

Scheduled Close

The B&D; app lets you schedule your garage door to close at set times. The most popular use case: set the door to close at 10pm every night. Forgot to close it after bringing the bins in? Doesn't matter — it'll close itself at your scheduled time.

You can set different schedules for different days, and the schedule runs regardless of the door's current state — if it's already closed, nothing happens.

Auto-Close Timer

The auto-close feature can be configured to automatically close the door after a set period following an open operation. Open the door to take the bins out, and it automatically closes after your configured interval — typically adjustable from one to several minutes.

The opener supports several auto-close modes:

- **Standard auto-close:** Closes the door after the set time period
- **Auto-close after close obstruction:** Reactivates auto-close after the safety system detects and handles an obstruction during closing
- **Auto-close after open obstruction:** Reactivates after an opening obstruction event
- **Auto-close after power up:** Enables auto-close following a power restoration

Timer Programming

For more granular control, the opener's built-in timer system supports up to eight timer programs across seven days. Each program can be set to one of four actions:

- **Close Door:** Door closes at the programmed time
- **Open Door:** Door opens and stays open from the programmed time
- **Stop Door:** Door won't operate until the next program starts
- **Free Door:** Release the controls from the timer

The Non-Negotiable Safety Rule

Safety Beams are compulsory for auto-close operation. This applies to every auto-close mode, every scheduling function, and every automated operation. Safety Beams must be properly installed and aligned. This isn't a recommendation — it's a requirement under Australian standards, and the opener won't engage auto-close without them.

Voice Control

Smart home enthusiasts want voice control, and B&D's ecosystem supports it — with some important caveats.

Google Home

B&D's smart garage features work with Google Home, allowing you to use voice commands through Google Home speakers, Google Nest displays, or any Google Assistant-enabled device. You can check the door status and control it with voice commands.

Siri Shortcuts

For Apple users, Siri Shortcuts integration lets you set up custom voice commands. "Hey Siri, close the garage" can trigger the close command through the B&D app. This works through iOS Shortcuts automation rather than a native HomeKit integration.

What to Expect

Voice control is genuinely useful for hands-free operation — you're carrying groceries, your hands are full of kids, you're in the middle of cooking. But it's worth being realistic: voice control for a garage door is a convenience feature, not a replacement for the app or geofencing. Most smart home users find they use geofencing daily, the app weekly, and voice control occasionally.

Multi-Door and Multi-Property Control

This is where B&D's smart ecosystem really shines for people who own more than one garage door — or more than one property.

Multiple Doors, One App

If your home has two or three garage doors (double garage plus a separate workshop, for example), each door with its own opener can be added to a single B&D app account. You see all doors on one

dashboard, control them individually, and receive separate alerts and activity logs for each.

Multiple Properties

For property investors and holiday home owners, multi-location support is a standout feature. You can manage garage doors at your primary residence, your beach house, and your investment property — all from the same app, all from wherever you are. Check the status of your investment property's garage door from your couch. Close the holiday house garage door when the cleaners leave. It's practical property management from your phone.

Adding Users

Each property can have multiple users with their own access levels and passwords. You might give your property manager full access to the investment property but read-only status at your home. Your teenagers might have app access but no ability to change settings. The multi-user system is flexible enough to handle most household and property management scenarios.

Security Integration

A smart garage door isn't just about convenience — it's a genuine security upgrade.

Activity Alerts

The B&D; app sends push notifications for door events. You can be alerted when:

- The door is opened unexpectedly (useful when you're away and no one should be accessing the garage)
- The door has been left open for an extended period
- The door is obstructed and can't close
- Someone uses a one-time visitor access code

Unexpected Opening Notifications

This is particularly valuable for security-conscious homeowners. If your garage door opens at 2am and no one in your household triggered it, you'll know immediately. For families, it provides peace of mind — you're notified the moment your teenager gets home and opens the garage.

Visitor Management

One-time access codes mean you never have to leave a key under the mat, hide a remote, or give permanent access to someone who only needs to get in once. Generate a code, share it with the tradesperson, and the code expires after use. You can see exactly when they accessed your garage in the activity log.

Pairing With Cameras

While B&D;'s smart system doesn't include cameras, it pairs naturally with any smart home camera setup. Position a camera in your garage or on your driveway, and when you receive a B&D; app notification that your door has opened, you can immediately check your camera feed to see who triggered it. The combination of door alerts and visual confirmation is powerful home security.

Future-Proofing Your Smart Garage

Smart home technology evolves quickly. Here's how B&D;'s ecosystem is positioned for the long term.

Battery Backup for Uninterrupted Smart Features

A smart garage door that stops working during a power outage isn't very smart. B&D;'s Battery Backup Kit keeps your opener running when the mains power goes out.

****What it provides:****

- Approximately 10 full open/close cycles on battery power - Average cycle time of 40 seconds for garage doors - 24 to 48 hours to fully recharge after depletion

****Important limitations to know:****

- Limit setup (adjusting door travel limits) is not available when running on batteries - Battery backup won't activate if a control system connected within 60 seconds before power loss (this allows time for a system reboot) - Battery backup won't activate if a fault condition was active before mains power was lost (this allows fault reset by cycling power)

For smart home enthusiasts, the Battery Backup means your geofencing, app control, scheduled close, and smart features continue working even during storms or power grid issues. Your automated routines don't miss a beat.

Firmware and App Updates

The B&D; app receives regular updates through the iOS App Store and Google Play Store, bringing new features and improvements to your existing hardware. This is one of the advantages of a connected system — your opener gets smarter over time without hardware changes.

B&D; Ecosystem Compatibility

B&D;'s smart platform is designed as a cohesive ecosystem. Whether you start with a Smart Pro or add a Smartphone Control Kit later, you're working within the same app, the same account structure, and the same feature set. As B&D; releases new smart features, they're available across the ecosystem — not locked to a single model.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need a Smart Pro to use the B&D; app?

No. The B&D; app works with any compatible B&D; opener when paired with the Smartphone Control Kit (MC0006). The Smart Pro has Wi-Fi built in, so it connects directly. Other openers need the Smart Hub from the control kit. Both give you the same app features.

Will the smart features work if my internet goes down?

The smart features that rely on the app — remote open/close, geofencing, notifications — require an internet connection. Your opener will still work normally via the wall button and remotes. When internet

is restored, smart features resume automatically.

Are Safety Beams really required?

Yes. Safety Beams are mandatory for any smart phone control, auto-close, or geofencing operation — any situation where the door operates without someone watching it. This is a safety requirement under AS/NZS 60335-2-95:2012. Your installer will fit them as part of any smart-enabled installation.

Can I control my garage door from overseas?

Yes. As long as your phone has an internet connection and your home's Wi-Fi and Smart Hub (or Smart Pro) are online, you can control and monitor your garage door from anywhere in the world.

How many people can use the app for one door?

Multiple users can be added, each with their own password and access level. There's no practical limit for household use. You can configure different permissions for different family members.

Does geofencing drain my phone battery?

Minimally. The B&D; app uses your phone's low-power geofencing capabilities rather than continuous GPS tracking. Most users report no noticeable battery impact. Both iOS and Android have mature, efficient geofencing APIs that the app leverages.

Can I use the Smartphone Control Kit with a roller door opener?

Yes. The kit is compatible with B&D;'s Roll-A-Pro roller door opener range, in addition to sectional door openers like the Power Drive and Secure models. Check compatibility if your opener was manufactured before May 2016.

What happens during a power outage?

Without a Battery Backup Kit, the opener won't operate and smart features are offline. With the Battery Backup Kit installed, you get approximately 10 full open/close cycles on battery power, and all smart features continue working as long as your Wi-Fi router also has power (or backup power).

Your Next Step

Ready to make your garage door smart? Here's what to do:

1. ****If you're installing a new opener:**** Ask your local B&D; Accredited Dealer about the Smart Pro (SDO-9V3). It's the simplest path to a fully connected garage — built-in Wi-Fi, no extras needed.
2. ****If you're keeping your current B&D; opener:**** Ask about the Smartphone Control Kit (MC0006). Your dealer can confirm compatibility with your specific opener model and manufacture date, and install the kit along with the mandatory Safety Beams.
3. ****If you want the full smart package:**** Consider adding a Battery Backup Kit to keep your smart features running during power outages. It's the final piece of a truly resilient smart garage setup.
