Your Garage Is a Showroom

If you have spent a Saturday morning hand-polishing a bonnet, adjusted your weekend plans around a detailing appointment, or lost sleep over a stone chip, you already know that owning a car you love changes the way you think about every space it occupies. Your garage is not just where the car sleeps. It is the environment that either preserves or slowly degrades the finish, the mechanical condition, and the value of something you have invested serious time, money, and emotion into.

Most garage doors are designed to keep weather out and let a car in. That is a low bar for an enthusiast. What you actually need is a system that controls the internal climate, seals out dust and contaminants, opens wide enough for today's vehicles without white-knuckle manoeuvring, secures your investment against forced entry, and — because you are an enthusiast — makes the daily ritual of arriving home and pulling into the garage feel like it should.

B&D's product ecosystem addresses every one of those requirements. The Panelift Icon sectional door provides the structural platform: tight sealing, wide openings, and clean aesthetics. The Smart Pro opener adds intelligent control, lighting, and quiet operation. Insul-Shield insulation manages temperature. Auto-Lock and Safety Beams handle physical security and protection. And Smart Phone Control ties it all together from your pocket.

This guide walks through every element — what it does, why it matters for your car, and how to configure a multi-door garage that works as well as the vehicles inside it.

Climate Control for Vehicle Protection

Temperature fluctuations inside a garage are one of the most overlooked threats to a vehicle's condition. When a hot day gives way to a cool night, metal surfaces cool faster than surrounding air, and moisture condenses directly onto paintwork, chrome, and glass. Over months and years, this cycle contributes to oxidation, dulling of clear coats, and — in coastal or humid areas — the early stages of corrosion on exposed metal components.

B&D's Insul-Shield option adds a layer of thermal insulation to your Panelift Icon panels. The insulated panels help moderate the internal temperature by reducing heat transfer through the door surface — the single largest opening in most garages and, therefore, the largest source of thermal gain and loss.

The practical effect is a more stable internal environment. On a 38-degree Melbourne summer day, an uninsulated steel door radiates heat into the garage, pushing internal temperatures well above ambient. An insulated door resists that transfer, keeping the garage cooler during the day and warmer overnight. The result is a narrower temperature band, which directly reduces condensation risk on vehicle surfaces.

For enthusiasts storing classic cars, particularly those with older single-stage paint or bare-metal engine bay components, this temperature stability is not a luxury. It is basic preservation. Even for modern daily drivers with factory clear coats, reducing thermal cycling extends the life of paint protection films, ceramic coatings, and wax layers — protecting the investment you have already made in detailing.

Insul-Shield also contributes to noise reduction from outside, which matters if your garage doubles as a workspace where you want to focus on mechanical work without street noise intruding.

Dust and Contaminant Sealing

Every car enthusiast knows the frustration: you detail a vehicle to perfection, park it in the garage, and within days a fine layer of dust has settled on every horizontal surface. In areas near construction, agricultural land, or busy roads, this problem is significantly worse. Dust is not just an aesthetic annoyance — fine particulates can contain abrasive minerals that micro-scratch clear coats when disturbed.

The Panelift Icon sectional door addresses this with comprehensive sealing around the full perimeter of the door. The system includes a jamb lintel seal and nylon bristle brush options that create a continuous barrier where the door meets the frame. At the bottom, the door's seal compresses against the garage floor to close the gap that is typically the largest source of dust ingress.

B&D's installation standards specify that draught seals should maintain maximum gaps not exceeding 3 mm — tight enough to significantly reduce airborne dust and moisture entry while still allowing the door to operate freely without binding.

For the enthusiast, this level of sealing serves a dual purpose. First, it keeps the environment around your stored vehicles cleaner, extending the time between details and reducing the risk of contact-based scratching from dust-laden cloths or covers. Second, in conjunction with Insul-Shield insulation, it creates a more controllable internal environment where temperature, humidity, and air quality are all closer to workshop standards than typical residential garage conditions.

If you are running an air filtration system or dehumidifier in your garage — common among serious collectors — effective door sealing is the foundation that makes those systems work efficiently rather than fighting a constant battle against outside air.

Wide Access for Wider Cars

Modern performance vehicles are wider than ever. A current-generation sports car or SUV can easily exceed 1,900 mm in body width, and once mirrors are factored in, you are looking at total widths approaching 2,200 mm or more. Threading a wide car through an undersized garage opening at low

speed, in reverse, with limited visibility is the kind of stress no enthusiast wants at the end of every drive.

The B&D; Panelift Icon sectional door is available in widths up to 5,500 mm and heights up to 3,000 mm. For a double garage, this provides generous clearance for two vehicles side by side, with comfortable room to open doors without scraping against the frame or the adjacent car.

For multi-car enthusiasts considering their garage layout, there is an important design decision: one wide double door versus two independent single doors. A single wide door maximises the clear opening and makes it easy to manoeuvre larger vehicles or access the full width of the garage for workshop activities. Two independent single doors, each with their own Smart Pro opener, give you the ability to open one bay while keeping the other sealed — useful for climate control, security, and noise when you are working in one bay and a car is stored in the other.

The Panelift Icon's minimum sideroom requirement of 120 mm over the door width (155 mm for rear torsion installations) and minimum headroom of 340 mm (295 mm for rear torsion, plus 50 mm for an automatic opener) mean the door can be fitted into most standard garage builds without structural modification. Check your specific opening dimensions, but in most cases, you can maximise door width right up to the available structural opening.

For lifted four-wheel drives or vehicles on roof racks, the 3,000 mm maximum height provides clearance that standard-height doors cannot match. You should not have to think about your garage door when loading a rooftop box for a weekend away.

Security — Protecting Your Investment

A garage full of vehicles you care about is, bluntly, a high-value target. Whether your concern is opportunistic break-in, forced entry, or simply knowing the door is closed when it should be, the security of your garage door system has direct financial and emotional consequences.

B&D;'s Auto-Lock system provides a physical security layer that goes well beyond a standard opener's holding force. When the door closes, the Auto-Lock automatically slides a steel bolt into the guide track, physically locking the door in place. This bolt engagement is automatic — it happens every close cycle without any action from you, so you never have to wonder whether you remembered to lock up.

If the door needs to be opened manually in an emergency, a lock/unlock button on the Auto-Lock allows disengagement. The lock then automatically re-engages after the next complete open-close cycle, returning to its secured state without intervention.

The Smart Pro opener adds a digital security layer through B&D;'s Tri-Tran code hopping technology. Every time you press your remote, the system generates a new security code from over 4.29 billion possible combinations, transmitted simultaneously across three frequencies (433.47 MHz, 433.92 MHz, and 434.37 MHz). This makes "code grabbing" — where a thief records and replays your remote signal — effectively impossible.

Smart Phone Control extends your security awareness beyond the garage itself. The system sends alerts when the door is left open or encounters an obstruction, and maintains an activity log that tracks every open and close event. You can monitor who opened the door and when, and if you have granted access to other users — a partner, a detailer, a trusted friend picking up a car — you can see exactly when they accessed the garage.

For car enthusiasts, this is not paranoia. It is the same logic that drives you to park in well-lit areas, avoid tight car park spaces, and choose the end bay at the shopping centre. You are protecting something you value, and the security system should match that commitment.

Safety Beams add protection for your vehicles as well as people. Mounted at the garage opening, these photo-electric sensors detect obstructions in the door's path and immediately stop or reverse the door's

travel. If a car's bonnet, a bicycle, or a child is in the path of a closing door, the Safety Beams override automatic operation. The beams should be periodically tested by obstructing the sensor during operation, and lenses cleaned regularly in dusty environments for optimal performance.

The Arrival Experience

This is where the enthusiast's garage door stops being purely functional and starts being part of the ownership experience.

Smart Phone Control with geofencing capability means the garage door can open automatically as you approach your home. You are driving back from a weekend run through the hills, and as you turn into your street, the door is already rising. No fumbling for a remote. No stopping in the driveway. You pull straight into a lit, open garage in one smooth motion.

The Smart Pro opener's built-in LED courtesy lights activate automatically when the door operates, flooding the garage with bright, efficient illumination the moment the door begins to move. These high-efficiency LEDs have a significantly longer lifespan than traditional incandescent globes and include a dimming function, so you can set the brightness to a level that works for your space — full brightness for workshop tasks, dimmed for ambient lighting when the car is on display.

For late-night returns — after an evening drive, a cars-and-coffee event, or a late finish at the workshop — quiet operation matters. You want to pull into the garage without waking the household or alerting the neighbours. The Smart Pro opener's operation is designed for exactly this scenario, giving you smooth, controlled door travel without the mechanical clatter of older systems.

The combination of geofenced opening, automatic lighting, and quiet operation transforms a mundane daily action — arriving home and parking the car — into something that feels deliberate, considered, and worthy of the vehicle you are driving.

Multi-Door Garages

Serious collectors and multi-car households often have two, three, or more garage bays, each serving a different purpose: daily driver storage, weekend car display, workshop space, or dedicated detailing bay. Managing multiple doors as independent, isolated systems is cumbersome and inefficient.

B&D's Smart Phone Control app allows you to operate multiple Smart Pro openers from a single interface. Each door operates independently — you can open the workshop bay while keeping the car storage bays sealed and climate-controlled — but all are visible and controllable from one screen on your phone.

This independent operation per bay is particularly valuable for climate management. If you are running a dehumidifier or air filtration system in your storage bay, you do not want that environment disrupted every time you open the workshop bay to bring in parts or tools. Separate doors with separate openers give you zone control over your garage environment.

The activity log tracks operations across all connected doors, so you have a complete picture of access across your entire garage. If your detailer accessed bay two at 9 AM and left at 11 AM, you can see that. If a door was opened unexpectedly at 2 AM, you will know about it.

You can also manage multiple locations — your home garage and a secondary storage facility or holiday house — from the same app, which is useful for enthusiasts whose collections have outgrown a single location.

Lighting and Visibility

Good lighting in a garage serves two purposes for an enthusiast: it lets you work safely and accurately, and it lets you see your cars properly.

The Smart Pro opener's integrated LED courtesy lights provide overhead illumination that activates with door operation and can be set to remain on for a configurable period after the door closes. The dimming function allows you to adjust brightness depending on the task — full brightness for inspecting a paint correction, dimmed for general ambient lighting.

For garages that double as workshops, consider the LED courtesy lights as a starting point rather than the complete solution. They provide excellent general illumination from a ceiling-mounted position, but dedicated task lighting — positioned at workbench height or angled to highlight specific work areas — will give you the directional light you need for mechanical work, detailing, and inspection.

The automatic activation of the courtesy lights means you never walk into a dark garage. Whether you are entering through the garage door or through an internal access door and triggering the opener, the lights come on without you reaching for a switch. For early morning starts and late evening returns, this is a small but meaningful quality-of-life feature.

Frequently Asked Questions

****Will Insul-Shield insulation actually make a difference in my garage temperature?**** Yes. Insul-Shield reduces heat transfer through the door — the largest opening in most garages. This moderates internal temperatures, narrowing the gap between daytime highs and overnight lows. The practical benefit is reduced condensation on vehicle surfaces and a more comfortable environment for working in the garage year-round.

****Can I control multiple garage doors from one phone?**** Yes. The B&D; Smart Phone Control app supports multiple Smart Pro openers, each operating independently. You can open, close, and monitor each door from a single interface, and the activity log tracks all operations across every connected door.

****How does the Auto-Lock work if the power goes out?**** The Auto-Lock's steel bolt remains engaged in the guide track regardless of power status. If the door was closed and locked when power was lost, it stays locked. In an emergency, you can disengage the bolt manually using the lock/unlock button on the Auto-Lock unit, then disengage the opener to operate the door by hand. The lock automatically re-engages after the next powered close cycle.

****Is the geofencing feature safe — will the door open when I do not want it to?**** The geofencing feature works through your smartphone's location services, triggering the door to open as you approach a defined zone around your home. You control the zone size and can enable or disable the feature at any time through the app. Safety Beams provide an additional layer of protection by detecting any obstruction in the door's path during operation.

****What is the maximum door width for a Panelift Icon?**** The Panelift Icon sectional door is available in widths up to 5,500 mm and heights up to 3,000 mm. Minimum sideroom requirement is 120 mm beyond the door width (155 mm for rear torsion installations), and minimum headroom is 340 mm (295 mm for rear torsion), plus an additional 50 mm if an automatic opener is being installed.

****Can I give my detailer temporary access to the garage?**** Yes. Smart Phone Control supports one-time access codes that you can issue to trusted professionals — your detailer, mechanic, or anyone else who needs temporary access. The activity log records when the code was used, so you have a complete record of who accessed the garage and when.
