The B&D; Remote Control Range

B&D; offers a comprehensive range of remote controls designed to work with their residential and commercial garage door openers. All current B&D; remotes use **Tri-Tran+ rolling code technology** — an encrypted security system that generates a new unique code with every button press, making it virtually impossible for thieves to intercept and copy your garage door signal.

Tri-Tran+ Premium Remote Control

The **Tri-Tran+ Premium Remote** is B&D;'s flagship handheld remote control. It combines premium build quality with advanced Tri-Tran+ security.

2 Button Transmitter

The **B&D; 2 Button Transmitter** is the standard remote for homes with one or two garage doors (or one garage door and one additional device like a gate).

Key features: - 2 independently programmable buttons - Tri-Tran+ rolling code security - Compact keyring-friendly size - LED transmission indicator - CR2032 battery (long life)

Best for: Single or double garage homes, or one garage plus one gate/access point.

4 Button Transmitter

The **B&D; 4 Button Transmitter** extends your control to up to four separate garage doors or devices.

The ****B&D; 4 Channel Transmitter**** is designed for more complex installations where multiple devices need to be controlled from a single unit.

****Best for:**** Properties with multiple B&D; openers across different areas (garage, side gate, carport, workshop).

B&D; Wall Mounted Remote

The ****B&D; Wall Mounted Remote**** provides a fixed control point inside your garage or home, eliminating the need to carry a handheld remote.

****Key features:**** - Fixed wall-mount design - Tri-Tran+ rolling code security - No battery to replace — hardwired power - Illuminated button for easy use in dark garages - Clean, modern aesthetic

****Important:**** If you have an older B&D; opener (pre-Tri-Tran+ era), you may need to check the full B&D; compatibility table at ****bnd.com.au**** or call ****1300 133 944**** to confirm which remotes are compatible with your specific model.

Older Opener Compatibility

B&D; has manufactured garage door openers for decades, and remote technology has evolved through several generations:

1. ****Tri-Tran+ (current)**** — Rolling code encryption, all current remotes 2. ****Tri-Tran (previous generation)**** — Earlier rolling code system 3. ****DIP switch (legacy)**** — Fixed code system using physical switches

Current Tri-Tran+ remotes are ****not backward compatible**** with older DIP switch openers. If you have a legacy opener, contact B&D; to discuss upgrade options.

How to Program Your B&D; Remote

Programming a B&D; Tri-Tran+ remote to your opener is straightforward. The process involves putting your opener into "learn mode" and then pressing the remote button you want to program.

Step-by-Step Programming Instructions

****What you'll need:**** - Your new B&D; remote (with battery installed) - Access to your B&D; garage door opener unit - A ladder (the opener is typically mounted on the ceiling)

****Programming process:****

1. ****Locate the LEARN button**** on your B&D; opener unit. This is typically a small button on the back or side of the opener head unit.
2. ****Press and release the LEARN button**** on the opener. The opener's LED will begin to flash, indicating it's in learn mode. You typically have 30 seconds to complete the next step.
3. ****Press and hold the remote button**** you want to program until the opener's LED changes (usually goes solid or flashes differently). This confirms the remote has been paired.
4. ****Test the remote**** by pressing the programmed button. The garage door should respond (open or close).
5. ****Repeat for additional buttons**** if you have a multi-button remote and want to program other buttons to the same or different openers.

Programming Multiple Remotes

Each B&D; opener can store multiple remotes. Simply repeat the learn process for each additional remote. This is useful for: - Providing remotes to family members - Having a spare remote - Adding a wall-mounted remote alongside handheld remotes

Clearing All Remotes

If you've lost a remote or want to start fresh (e.g., after moving into a new home), you can clear all programmed remotes from the opener:

1. ****Press and hold the LEARN button**** on the opener for approximately 10 seconds 2. The LED will flash rapidly and then go out, confirming all remotes have been erased 3. ****Re-program**** your current remotes using the standard process above

****Security tip:**** If you move into a home with an existing B&D; opener, always clear all remotes and re-program only your own. This ensures previous owners cannot access your garage.

Battery Replacement Guide

All B&D; handheld remotes use standard coin cell batteries that are widely available from supermarkets, electronics stores, and hardware shops.

How to Replace the Battery

1. **Locate the battery compartment** — Most B&D; remotes have a small slot or screw on the back
2. **Open the compartment** — Use a coin or small flathead screwdriver to open
3. **Note the battery orientation** — Before removing the old battery, note which side faces up (+ or -)
4. **Insert the new battery** — Place the new CR2032 with the correct orientation (usually + side up)
5. **Close the compartment** — Snap or screw the cover back in place
6. **Test the remote** — Press a button and check the LED flashes. Test with your garage door.

Note: Replacing the battery does **not** erase your programming. Your remote will continue to work with your existing opener pairings.

Signs Your Remote Battery Is Low

- Reduced operating range (you need to be closer to the garage)
- LED indicator is dim or doesn't light up
- Inconsistent response (works sometimes, not others)
- Remote stops working entirely

Troubleshooting B&D; Remote Controls

Remote Not Working

Check these in order:

1. **Battery** — Replace the CR2032 battery first. This is the most common cause.
2. **Range** — Stand within 5 metres of the opener and try again. If it works close up but not from the driveway, it's likely a low battery or interference issue.
3. **Programming** — The remote may have lost its pairing. Re-program using the learn process above.
4. **Opener power** — Check the opener unit has power (LED should be on). Check the power point hasn't been switched off.
5. **Antenna** — Ensure the opener's antenna wire is hanging down freely and hasn't been tucked up or damaged.

Remote Works Intermittently

- **Interference** — LED lights, nearby electronics, or metal structures can interfere with the signal. Try repositioning the opener's antenna.
- **Battery** — A partially depleted battery can cause intermittent operation. Replace it.
- **Multiple openers** — If you have multiple openers, ensure you're pressing the correct button for the correct door.

Remote LED Flashes But Door Doesn't Move

- The remote is transmitting but the opener isn't receiving. Check:
 - Opener antenna
 - Distance to opener
 - Whether the opener is in "lock" mode (some openers have a lock function that disables remote operation)
 - Whether the opener's safety beams are obstructed

Lost All Remotes

If you've lost all your remotes:

1. Purchase a new compatible B&D; remote (any Tri-Tran+ remote will work with current openers)
2. Access the opener unit directly
3. Program the new remote using the learn button process
4. Consider programming a B&D; Wall Mounted Remote as a backup that can't be lost

Adding Smart Control to Your B&D; Remote Setup

Beyond traditional remotes, B&D; offers smart connectivity options:

B&D; Smart Phone Control Kit (HUB100)

The Smart Phone Control Kit turns your smartphone into a garage door remote:

- **What's included:** Wireless hub (HUB100), power supply, wall bracket, network transceiver module
- **Compatibility:** Works with CAD Secure (SDO-6) and PanelMax (SDO-8) openers -
- Connectivity:** 2.4GHz WiFi - **Requirement:** Must be connected to power at all times -
- Features:** Open/close from anywhere, receive notifications, check door status, share access with family

B&D; Smart Door Solutions

B&D;'s Smart and Smart Pro openers have built-in Bluetooth and WiFi connectivity, allowing direct smartphone control without additional hardware.

Important: Only purchase genuine B&D; remotes. Third-party "compatible" remotes may not support Tri-Tran+ encryption and could compromise your garage security.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use one remote for multiple garage doors?

Yes. The B&D; 4 Button Transmitter and 4 Channel Transmitter let you program each button to a different opener, so you can control up to 4 garage doors from a single remote.

How many remotes can one opener store?

B&D; openers can typically store up to 32 remotes. This is more than enough for a household plus spares.

Will my B&D; remote work with a non-B&D; opener?

No. B&D; Tri-Tran+ remotes are designed exclusively for B&D;/ATA openers. They will not work with Merlin, Chamberlain, or other brands.

My remote range has decreased. What should I do?

Replace the battery first. If range is still poor, check the opener's antenna is hanging freely, and check for sources of radio interference (LED downlights are a common culprit).

Can someone copy my B&D; remote signal?

Tri-Tran+ rolling code technology makes signal copying virtually impossible. Each button press generates a unique encrypted code, so even if someone intercepts a transmission, it can't be reused.

I moved into a new house. Should I reprogram the opener?

Absolutely. Clear all existing remotes from the opener (hold LEARN for 10 seconds) and program only your own remotes. This ensures the previous owner's remotes no longer work.
