Factors That Affect Garage Door Cost

1. Door Size

Standard single doors (approximately 2,400mm wide × 2,100mm high) are the base price. Costs increase for: - ****Double doors**** — 50–80% more than a single - ****Extra height**** — Common for SUVs and 4WDs, adds 10–20% - ****Extra width**** — Custom widths beyond standard cost more

2. Material and Finish

- ****Standard Colorbond**** — Base pricing across all B&D; doors - ****Timber-look finishes**** — Premium pricing for Natural Finishes and wooden aesthetic options - ****Custom colours**** — May attract surcharges beyond the standard Colorbond palette

3. Insulation

Frequently Asked Questions About Garage Door Costs

How long does a garage door last? A quality B&D; garage door can last 20–30 years with proper maintenance. Openers typically last 10–15 years.

Is it cheaper to repair or replace? As a rule of thumb, if repair costs exceed 50% of replacement cost, or if the door is over 15–20 years old, replacement usually makes more financial sense.

Can I install a garage door myself to save money? B&D; requires professional installation by an authorised dealer for warranty coverage. DIY installation also poses serious safety risks, particularly with spring systems.

Does my garage door need council approval? Generally, like-for-like replacements don't require council approval. However, if you're changing the door type or your property has heritage restrictions, check with your local council first.
