Melbourne-Specific Installation Considerations

Building Permits - Like-for-like replacements generally don't need a permit - New installations or significant changes may require building approval - Heritage overlay zones have additional requirements — check with your council - Some body corporate rules in apartment complexes restrict door changes

Common Melbourne Garage Configurations - **Single front-facing** — Typical in older suburbs (Northcote, Brunswick, Essendon) - **Double side-by-side** — Common in 1980s–2000s suburban

developments - ****Tandem / long narrow**** — Found in inner-city terraces and narrow blocks - ****Under-house**** — Two-storey homes with garage below, common in hilly suburbs

Maintenance Schedule for Melbourne Conditions

B&D; recommends adjusting your maintenance schedule for Melbourne's conditions:

- ****Every 14 days**** — Wash Colorbond and steel doors with clean water and soft brush (essential for bayside properties) - ****Monthly**** — Test auto-reverse and safety beam functions - ****Every 3 months**** — Clean roller door tracks with mineral turps (never grease or oil). Inspect weather seals. - ****Every 6 months**** — Full visual inspection of springs, cables, and hardware - ****Annually**** — Professional service by your local B&D; dealer
